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Key Challenges faced by Indian Utilities in Asset Management



OPERATIONS

- · High unplanned downtime
- People dependent, manual processes
- High operational cost
- Reduced performance



MAINTENANCE

- · Ad-hoc maintenance of assets
- Higher reactive maintenance
- Increasing failure of ageing assets
- Difficulties in achieving in IT/ OT integration



INVENTORY MANAGEMENT

- Absence of activity-based inventory planning
- Inefficient supplier service agreements
- Difficulties in predicting accurate demands



DATA MANAGEMENT

- Siloed operations with disparate systems
- Uncertainty in analytics implementation costs
- Inconsistent data quality
- Enterprise-wide view of Asset related data not available




